



## **KOTA 2021 Annual Conference Call For Papers**

KOTA appreciates your interest and participation in our most recent Call for Papers for the 2021 Annual Conference. The conference will be held **Sept 23-25 at Embassy Suites in Olathe, KS**. We aim to offer a variety of topics with an emphasis on techniques and evidence that practitioners and educators can use when they return to work. We are seeking sessions that will incorporate both lecture and hands-on type of formats. We are also seeking to fill sessions with topics that will fit different practice areas and populations. Due to the positive response we received after the 2020 conference we are hoping to also offer virtual-only sessions and are seeking speakers for this format as well.
